Program Highlight Abbeville Clinic Janice Gray	Janice provided the board with Abbeville Clinic service provided number of open cases. Introduced important facts about her current and new staff giving their specialty and length of Beckman service.	
Center Director's Report Tacey Perillo	January was a good month to get out to some of our counties and start the year being able to talk about restructuring and being available to staff. We are sharing everything as information becomes available. Answer questions or acknowledge the great work they are doing. Plan on continuing to visit at least two counties per month on a rotating basis. ACT- Staff continue to interview and advertise for missing team positions. They have added one new team member this January. CCBHC-Continue to focus on Wellness Groups, Smoking Cessation and the other elements that are ongoing. Our collaborative with Carolina Health Centers has been of a great benefit to our patients. OIDD- assessments are booked through March with Beckman referrals. Referring therapist will be invited to attend the assessment.	
Chief of Staff Report Koshay Arnold (Out) Amanda Blocker reported.	- We are currently projecting a surplus \$137,353 by the end of the fiscal year. - We are currently in the process of working with a realtor who has a building that can be remodeled to meet our needs for potentially moving our Abbeville Clinic. The building in the center of town and within walking distance for many residents. There are no concrete plans. We are at the beginning stages of looking at the feasibility, but I wanted to make you aware that this is a potential option, pending approval by the Department of Administration of course.	

Deputy Director's Report Melaine Gambrell	Ms Gambrell reviewed new structure and administrative positions posted for hire. Reviewed new financial arrangements with the department of administration and their weekly guidance regarding restructuring.	
Medical Director Report Dr. Eman Sharawy	Discussed staffing of complex multiagency involved patients at state level for a multi-agency response. Locally we continue to treat resistant depression with the Sprivato clinic. February, we conducted our peer review and analyzed results for CARF. We continue to precept nurse practitioner students.
